



To all Tenants at Bethesda Towers,

On Thursday, May 13, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued a statement advising that, “Fully vaccinated people do not need to wear masks outdoors and can avoid wearing them indoors in most places.” As a result of this announcement and the continued decrease in new cases and increasing vaccines being administered, mask mandates and COVID mitigation measures around the region over the last few weeks have been lifted and/or revised by DC, Maryland, and Virginia governments.

Currently, CDC guidelines state that fully vaccinated individuals do not have to wear masks in most indoor settings, except on public transit, in health care facilities, and in congregate settings. Businesses retain the ability to require masks in their establishments. Those who are unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated are strongly encouraged to wear masks in all settings.

For the time being, Moore & Associates will continue to request masks be worn within common areas and elevators. It is our goal to maintain a building environment where our tenants feel safe, and we ask your cooperation in adhering to this recommendation. We will continue to provide updates to building policies and provide recommendations as we feel are appropriate.
